Features of the museum and pass:

- Free daytime General Admission for 6 participants (last entry 4pm)
- Not recommended for children under the age of seven
- Includes “The Voices of Eastern State” audio tour, hands-on history interactive experiences, history exhibits, and artist installations
- Photographers using a tripod must purchase an equipment pass for an additional fee of \$10. No portrait photography is permitted during public hours
- Eastern State is open rain or shine & the building does not have climate control
